


<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>We are using the book “One Small Step” to help us write about Neil Armstrong. After that we will be reading and writing Turkish folk tales and myths.</p> <p>You can help by ensuring that you read with your child every day and update their Reading Records. Please also ensure your child completes their spellings every week and uses Spellodrome.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>We are learning about fraction, properties of shapes, time and mass/capacity. We will continue to be practising different methods of calculation and times tables.</p> <p>You can help by continuing to support your children with their addition and subtraction facts within 20. We are learning the 3, 6 4 and 8 times tables, please practise these with your children. Keep supporting your children with learning to tell the time.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Topic</p> <p>We are continuing to make our space suits for our Moon Topic. After that we will be learning about Turkey, this will include cooking, making Ottoman lamps and the geography of the country.</p> <p>You can help by supporting your child to research about Turkey before we begin our learning. If any adults have any links to Turkey and would be willing to talk to the children, please talk to Ms Waugh or Mr West regarding this.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>We are linking our learning in science closely to our topic of the moon. We will be investigating eclipses.</p> <p>You can help by discussing the Solar System with your child, including where the Earth and Moon fits within it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>With Mr Paxton, we will be playing hockey matches the first few weeks, learning about how to attack and defend as a team. We will then prepare for sports day by covering different types of racing, jumping and throwing. The children will be choreographing a dance which will be performed for parents during week 2.</p> <p>Puffin Class PE Kit needed Tuesdays and Fridays. We will compose simple ostinati and melodies and play simple 2 part pieces and rounds on the recorder.</p>

As well as describing the flags using colours and shapes in Spanish.</p> <p>You can help by practicing what they have learnt in class at home.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Homework</p> <p>Reading: please aim to read every night for 15 minutes with your child. Please also ensure the Reading Record is completed and signed daily. Reading every day will support your child's learning across every aspect of the curriculum.</p> <p>Independent learning project: the children will be given a selection of activities to complete over the half term. The children are expected to pick at least three of the activities and bring their work into school ready for a celebration in the final week of the half term. The children can also choose to do their own activities if it is linked to the topic.
